President's Message


I hope everyone had a great Holiday Season and I wish everyone a Very Happy, Healthy and prosperous New Year!

AUNT IDA'S PRESSED COOKIES

2/3 Cup White Sugar + extra

2/3 Cup Brown Sugar

2 Cups Quick Oatmeal

1/2 Cup Finely Chopped Nuts

2/3 Cup Butter

2 Eggs

1 teaspoon Vanilla

2 Cups Flour

1/2 teaspoon Baking Soda

1 teaspoon Baking Powder

1/2 teaspoon Salt

F Pre-heat Oven to 325 degrees Cream butter then add sugars. oatmeal and nuts.



E Blend in eggs and vanilla.

E Sift together flour, soda, baking powder and salt.

E Mix with other ingredients.

© Drop small teaspoons full of dough on greased or parchment lined cookie sheets.

EDip a flat bottomed glass in sugar then press dough flat.

(Dampen glass bottom to get the sugar to stick, then twist slightly when flattening dough to keep dough from sticking to the bottom of the glass.)

EBake 10 to 12 minutes.

Makes 6 dozen.
