Moroccan-Inspired Sweet Potato Soup



Makes 4 servings | Total time: 30 minutes

Ingredients:

2 tbsp. olive oil, 1 small chopped yellow onion, 1 chopped red bell pepper, 3 or 4 minced garlic cloves, 1 32-oz. carton vegetable broth, 1 16-oz. pkg. diced sweet potato, 1 tsp. ground cumin, 1/2 tsp. ground cinnamon, 1/4 tsp. crushed red pepper flakes, 1 15-oz. can garbanzo beans, 4 cups chopped kale, salt & pepper to taste

1. Add all ingredients except kale into 6-qt. electric pressure cooker. Cover, lock lid and position steam valve to seal. Select Pressure Cook on High for 1 minute.

2. Carefully turn steam valve to vent to quick release pressure. Stir in kale until wilted. Season with salt and pepper.



Southern Corn Casserole By Paula Deen

Ingredients

- 1 (15 1/4 oz) can drained whole kernel corn
- 1 (14 3/4 oz) can cream-style corn
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1/2 cup (1 stick) melted butter
- 1 (8 oz) package corn muffin mix
- medium shredded cheddar cheese



Directions

In a large bowl, stir together the two cans of corn, corn muffin mix, sour cream and butter. Pour into a greased casserole. Bake at 350 °F for 40 to 45 minutes, or until golden brown. Top with generous amount of cheddar cheese and return to oven for another 5 minutes until cheese is melted.
